"Hugh B. Urban Scientology Collection" in the OSU library Special Collections

"The Hugh B. Urban Special Collection on the Church of Scientology was compiled between 2000 and 2012. The materials in the collection include books, magazines, scholarly journals, VHS tapes, DVDs, audio tapes, electronic materials on CD-rom, and an array of ephemera. Among them are not only Church of Scientology publications but also scholarly works, anti-cult literature, journalistic publications and the complete FBI files on Hubbard, Dianetics and Scientology obtained through FOIA. The materials were compiled from a variety of sources. Many new editions of books and audio CDs were donated by the Church of Scientology's Bridge Publications and Golden Era Productions; three huge collections of books, magazines and ephemera were donated by ex-Scientologists; one large library of rare first-edition books was donated by a private collector; and a massive digital archive of scanned books, magazines, and ephemera spanning 40 DVDs was donated by a former OSU student. Finally, an array of other materials was obtained from private sellers, used booksellers and online auctions such as E-bay. The collection continues to grow as new donors offer their materials on a regular basis."
